On Sunday July 5th Salem U. M. Church will re-launch our in-person worship!

That is, we will resume, if nothing happens between now and then to disrupt that. The 8:30 Church on the Lake service and our 10:30 Sanctuary Service will begin on the same day. You should expect changes in both services. A letter went out to most Salem households detailing those changes.

What needs to be said further is that the most important part of the re-launch is that only those who feel ready, those who feel healthy, those who feel safe being in crowds ought to attempt to return. Please be careful and honest with yourself. The truth of the matter is that re-launching is a bit scary for everyone. We have heard news reports of churches that have attempted to open their doors and gather together, only to have a report of a member becoming ill with the Covid 19 Virus. In some instances, the entire group has had to be self-quarantined for 14 days after.

Precautions are being taken, plans are in place and are adjusted accordingly on a regular basis, but the reality remains...gathering together is risky, even to worship the most holy God almighty. Please, please, please consider carefully. If you are high risk, if you are feeling ill in any manner whatsoever (Covid symptoms or something else), if you are the least little bit hesitant ... stay home. We will see you in a couple of weeks. Better that, than having all of us faced with a closed door once again.

Plans are being made to continue streaming the service at least throughout the summer, longer if need be. It is on Facebook.
